SAN FRANCISCO.... By drawing an object, artist Susan Manchester comes to understand both its shape and substance. She is currently working on a series of life-size figures and botanical studies. "My interest is engaged and sustained not so much by the form and figure of the piece but by the luminescence that begins to emanate from inside the drawing itself," she says.

As a student, Manchester's love of drawing led her to study printmaking, especially etching, and she still devotes a portion of her time to collaborating with master printers. She lives in Monterey, CA, and her new drawings can be seen at Edith Caldwell Gallery, where she has shown her work since 1992.
